## MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES

All water service charges shall be due on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the month. An account for charges prescribed by this article shall be deemed delinquent if payment is not received by the due date (10<sup>th</sup> day of the month). Water service will be disconnected ten (10) days after the delinquency date, which shall be on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of the month. A late Penalty charge of 10% of the customer's water bill will be accessed on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of each month.

## DAMAGE TO CITY OWNED PROPERTY OR EQUIPMENT

The following fees will be charged to the water customer's water account for damage to the water meters:

- a. Charge for **broken or cutoff valve** will be a fifty dollar (\$50.00) charge to the customer's water account.
- b. Charge for broken meter or broken meter register will be a one hundred dollar (\$100.00) charge to the customer's water account.
- c. Charge for a **broken or missing barrel lock** will be a twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) charge to the customer's water account.
- d. Charge for a **broken or missing padlock** will be a forty dollar (\$40.00) charge to the customer's water account.

- e. Charge for illegal hook-up to a fire hydrant and/or flush valve will be a one hundred dollar (\$100.00) charge to the violator or to the violator's water account or prosecution under Section 28.03 of the Texas Penal Code.
- f. Minimum charge for water consumed due to illegal hook-up to at a fire hydrant and/or flush valve will be five hundred dollar (\$500.00) charge to the violator, violator's water account or prosecution under Section 28.03 of the Texas Penal Code.
  - g. Disconnect Charge \$50.00
  - h. Reconnect Charge \$30.00
  - i. Shutoff notice fee \$25.00
