

DECLARATION OF DISASTER FOR PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, beginning in December 2019, a novel coronavirus, now designated as COVID-19, was detected in mainland China, and has since spread throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a worldwide pandemic on March 11, 2020; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Madisonville has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to contain COVID-19 and prevent its spread throughout Madisonville, Texas; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MADISONVILLE, TEXAS:


1. That a local state of disaster was initially declared to pursuant to 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code for the City of Madisonville on March 16, 2020.
2. Pursuant to 418.018(b) of the Government code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than thirty days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Madisonville.
3. Pursuant to 418.018(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the city secretary.
4. Pursuant to 418.018(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activation of the County Emergency Management Plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance and shall be elated to activities that have occurred and will occur in conjunction with the event described above.

City Council has officially extended the disaster declaration for the City of Madisonville for 30 days.
