Job Title: Water Utility Maintenance

Job Description: Under the supervision of the Public Works Director, the Water Utility Maintenance personnel is responsible for the installation and repair of water distribution and wastewater collection system; and does related works as required.

Required 5 days/40 hours a week. Subject to after hour calls for emergency situations on weekends and nights.

Must work effectively with other employees to assist with utility repair and handle water meter issues. Personnel will repair or replace water or sewer service lines and water or sewer mains, install water and sewer taps, install or repair fire hydrants, unstop sewer lines, install clean-outs, set up barricades when needed to protect employees or the public, and perform routine maintenance on vehicles, tools and equipment.

Must be able to read, understand and follow written and oral directions, write reports by hand, and use good judgement to work safely, and use equipment properly. Must be able to hear clearly when working around equipment or in street traffic; using proper safety precautions may need to lift up to 100 pounds and pull, push or drag up to 150 pounds of street equipment. Must be able to climb, crawl, kneel, squat, stoop and bend; and sit for long periods of time while operating equipment. Personnel will perform other duties as assigned, including assisting other departments.

Job Requirements: One-year related field experience is preferred but not mandatory. Must possess an aptitude to make minor repairs and adjustments to equipment in the field. Willing attain a D Water License within one year. A high school diploma or GED and a valid Texas Driver's License Class C are required.

The successful candidate for the Water and Sewer Utility position for the City of Madisonville should be self-motivated, have an appreciation for accuracy, efficiency and safety, and be able to work independently while following written and oral direction. Must be able to pass a background check.

Compensation: Salary is dependent on background and qualifications. The City of Madisonville offers a generous benefits program including retirement, health and life insurance, paid vacation and sick leave.
